Over the June school holidays, we had 4 flagpoles installed – 2 at each campus – so that we could fly the Indigenous flag and the Torres Strait Islander flags, along with our established Australian flag. We'd like to thank members of our Junior School Council for writing to Claire O'Neill's Office, and requesting 4 brand new flags. They arrived at our school last term, ready to be displayed last week. The cost of the project was just over \$4,200 and we were able to fund it through the generosity of families who contributed to our Building Fund (\$1,638), Student Voice funds (\$1,750) and fundraising funds (\$1,024).
